It is important that teachers maintain communication with parents and carers on their child's progress and wellbeing.


It is normally a requirement for Commonwealth funding, that schools report twice a year, providing A-E ratings. Due to the disruption caused by COVID-19 the Commonwealth government has advised that there will be flexibility for 2020 Mid-year reporting. The requirement to report A-E ratings has been removed.

The Tasmanian Department of Education is expecting that teachers in primary schools will have communicated with parents and carers each student's wellbeing and level of learning achievement in English and Maths, by the end of July. Learning achievement is to be recorded as working towards the standard, at the standard or above the standard. The communication is to also include the next steps in learning.

This expectation is in place for students from Prep to Year 6. Students with personal learning plans will be assessed against their learning goals. Kindergarten students do not receive a mid-year report.

Schools are able to decide how they share student progress and wellbeing information, either through a telephone or online conversation, or in writing. At MHPS we have decided to provide written communication for our families. We will send home reports with the students on Wednesday I July.
